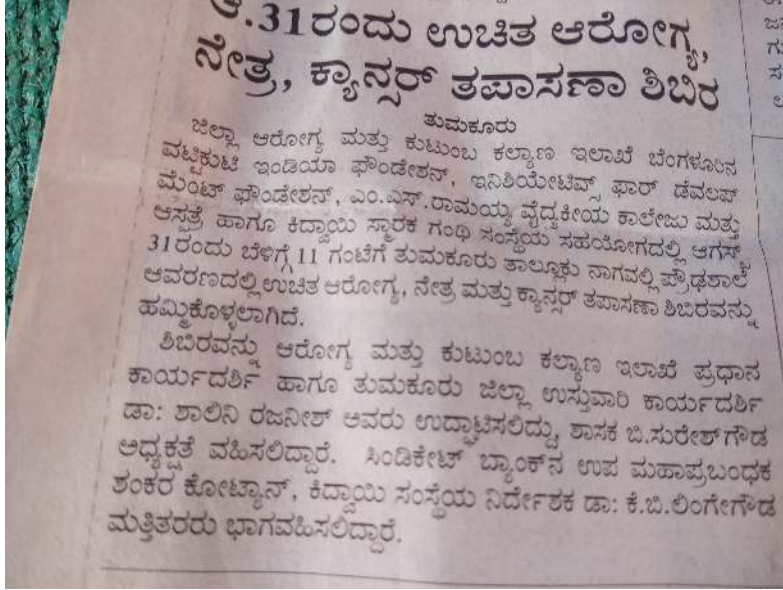

In total, 172 villagers availed the free health services in the free medical health camp organised by **Vattikuti India Foundation** from the neighbouring villages. 22 patients were identified during the camp for cataract surgeries and were taken to MS Ramaiah Hospital for the surgeries.
